

Improved Cooking Stove: Information Sheet (Till June, 2017)

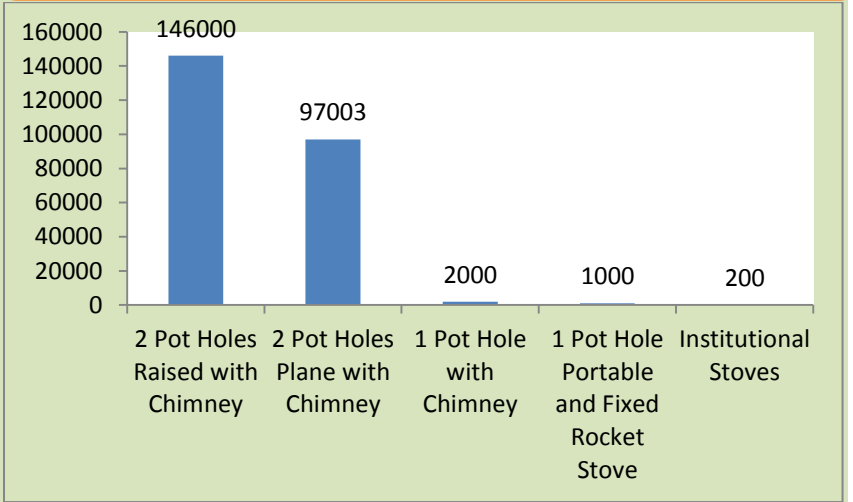
NCDC has been facilitating for the promotion and dissemination of biomass energy technologies in Ilam, Panchthar, Taplejung, Bhojpur, Sankhuwashava, Terhathum, Dhankuta, Jhapa and Sunsari districts since 2003¹. As a RSC, NCDC implements this program through the Local Partner Organization (LPO) of the respective districts in the hilly area and District Renewable Energy Service Center (DRESC) in the Terai region. Till present, NCDC has already facilitated to install 246,303 ICS in 205 Village Development Committees (VDCs) of nine districts through 18 partner organizations.

Namsaling Community Development Centre (NCDC) is working as a Regional Service Center (RSC) of Alternative Energy Promotion Center (AEPC) since January, 2001. As a RSC, NCDC facilitates the promotion and dissemination of renewable energy technologies in seven hilly and 2 terai districts of Eastern Development Region, Nepal

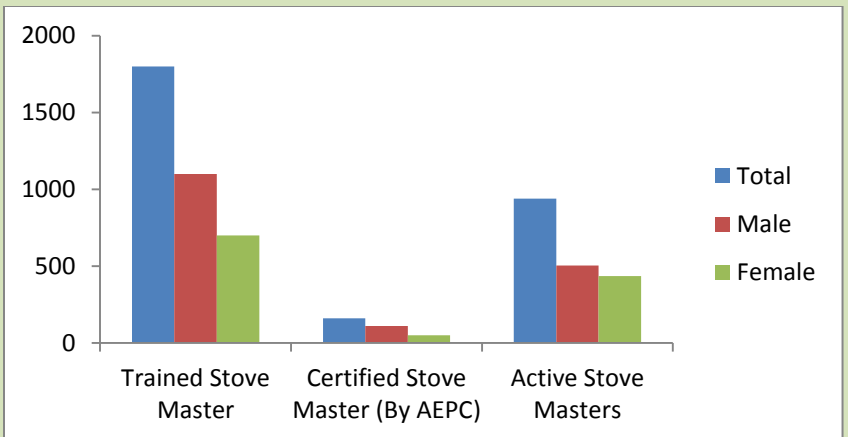
Beside this, NCDC has distributed metallic improved cooking stoves to all the households of Kalinchowk VDC in Dolakha district after the aftermath of disastrous earthquake of 2015. As a result, the VDC has now been declared Indoor Air Pollution (IAP) free.

NCDC has been part of exchange program funded by Fredskorpset (FK), Norway since 2004. From 2009 – 2016, NCDC was part of volunteers exchange as a part of the program – Sustainable Energy Service for Households. Till present, NCDC has participated in eight rounds of exchanges under different themes such as sustainable development, ecological agriculture, environment conservation, climate change and sustainable energy. At present, NCDC has been the lead partner of a consortium with partner organizations

from Tanzania, India, Nepal, Mozambique and Kenya to implement a project with an aim to enhance and promote private sector for rural livelihood improvement. Currently, from NCDC, a staff has been working for FEDESMO in Mozambique and a staff from YVE Kenya has been working with NCDC.
